Home Builders Association Donates \$2,300 to St. Anthony's de Greeff Hospice House

2009 HBA President **Dan Barnard** of **Greater Missouri Builders** (left) presented a \$2,300 donation to **Gail Barwick** (center), patient care coordinator for St. Anthony's de Greeff Hospice House, and **Jeff Randall**, executive director for St. Anthony's Charitable Foundation, on behalf of the Home Builders Charitable Foundation.

The funds will be used to repair and replace a damaged kitchen floor at the de Greeff Hospice House. The St. Anthony's de Greeff Hospice House was built almost 12 years ago through donated funds and has since become home to approximately 2,000 terminally ill patients. Although there is some third party reimbursement for a portion of medical costs, there is nothing to assume the expenses of room and board for these patients. St. Anthony's simply assumes these costs. No one is turned away because of lack of financial resources.

The HBA is a local trade association of nearly 1,000 member firms representing the residential construction industry. The Home Builders Charitable Foundation, the HBA's charitable arm, is a non-profit organization dedicated to providing housing assistance to people or organization with special shelter needs.
