This award recognizes the long term contributions of HBA builders to the St. Louis area.

There are five categories: Starter Homes, Move-Up Homes, Luxury Homes, Multi-Builder Community and Multi-Price community. Communities must be between five and fifteen years old and ninety percent complete. More than one entry can win in each category.

Judging is based on style and condition of the subdivision, the streetscape, re-sale values, use of trees and how the neighborhood benefited the surrounding community.
