The content being shared in this course was developed by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), in collaboration with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to properly train all contractors to work safely in housing with lead-based paint in order to comply with the EPA's Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP) Rule and HUD's Lead Safe Housing Rule. Successful completion of this course meets the new EPA training criteria that went into effect in April, 2010 (with certain training extensions through October, 2010). Courses are approved for purposes of certification under Section 402 of TSCA for the respective discipline. This training is required for all contractor types involved in construction activity in pre-1978 housing that will or has the potential to disturb painted surfaces.

ALL paid renovators/contractors who work in pre-1978 housing, including: renovation contractors, maintenance workers in multi-family housing, painters, plumbers and other specialty trades that disturb painted surfaces through renovation, repair or painting activities must comply with this EPA rule. The rule does not apply to minor maintenance or repair activities where less than six square feet of lead-based paint is disturbed in a room or where less than 20 square feet of lead-based paint is disturbed on the exterior. Window replacement is not considered minor maintenance or repair.
